

The Chivalrous Mysteries: Mysteria Nobilia

The three theological virtues (prior to Hail Mary)

1. ***for the increase of faith: pro augmento fidei***
2. ***for the increase of hope: pro augmento spei***
3. ***for the increase of charity: pro augmento caritatis***

*...or the Special - **Chivalrous gifts** (after Jesus in Hail Mary)*

1. *Who may keep our vigilance: Qui vigiliam nostram custodiat*
2. *Who may strengthen our holiness and courage: Qui Sanctitatem et Fortitudinem nostram confirmet*
3. *Who may deepen our obedience, charity, and humility: Qui nostram Obedientiam, Caritatem, et Humilitatem magnificet*

The [First/Second...] **Chivalrous Mystery is...**:

[Primum/Secundum/Tertium/Quartum/Quintum/(Sextum)] **Mysterium Nobile** est...

1. The Trial in the desert: Tentatio in deserto

Transformed: Hail Mary...Jesus, Who resisted temptation in the wilderness...: Ave Maria...Jesus, Qui tentationem in deserto restitisti...

Original: ...Who defeated the devil in the desert...: ...Qui vicit diabolum in deserto...

2. The Ordination of the (72) Disciples as Exorcists: Ordinatio (Septuaginta Duorum) Discipulorum ad Exorcizandum

...Who gave the disciples the gift of deliverance...: ...Qui dedit discipulis virtutem ad liberandum a daemonis...

...Who gave the power to the disciples to drive out all demons...: ...Qui dedit discipulis virtutem et potestatem super omnia daemonia... (Straight quote from Lk 9:1)

3. The Recognition of Jesus' Authority: Recognitio Autoritatis Jesu

...before Whom the entire spiritual world bows...: ...Cui omnis spiritus genu flectit...

...Who was recognized by the impure spirits to be the Son of God...: ...Qui a daemonis immundis est recognitus Filius Dei...

4. The Sending thence of the Demonic Legion: Amissio Legionis Daemonium

...Who restored the man from the Gergesene region...: ...Qui virum Gerasenorum restauravit...

...Who let a legion of demons go into a herd of pigs...: ...Qui legionem daemonium ad gregem porcorum permisit...

5. Jesus' Sacrifice on the Cross: Sacrificio Jesu in Cruce

...Who redeemed us by His Crucifixion, Death and Resurrection...: ...Qui Crucifixione, Morte, et Resurrectione Ejus nos redemit... *or, following the ancient Te Deum Hymn* - ...Qui Pretioso Sanguine nos redemit...

...Who triumphed over satan by His Crucifixion, Death, and Resurrection...: ...Qui Crucifixione, Morte, et Resurrectione (*or perhaps* Pretioso Sanguine) vicit satanam...

(6). Mary, the Woman Clothed with the Sun, (New Eve, and CoRedemptrix):

Maria, Mulier Amicta Sole, ((Heva Nova, et CoRedemptrix)

...Who Clothed Thee in His Divine Power...: ...Qui Te induit Divina Potestate Ejus...

...Who redeemed us with Thy participation in His Cross...: ...Qui participatione Tua in Cruce Ejus nos redemit...

The [First, Second...] **Eschatological Mystery is...**: [Primum, Secundum, Tertium, Quartum, Quintum, (Sextum)] **Mysterium Eschatologicale/de Fine** est...

1. The Three Days of Darkness: Tres Dies Tenebrarum

2. The Age of Mary/Peace (The Marian Peace): Saeculum Mariae/Pacis (Pax Mariana)

3. The Defeat of the AntiChrist: Devictio AntiChristi

-/4. The Triumph (of the Sacred Heart and) the Immaculate Heart of Mary: Victoria (Sacratissimi Cordis et) Cordis Immaculati Mariae

4/5. The Second Coming and Final Judgment: Adventum Secundum et Judicium Generale

5/6. The New Heavens and New Earth: Novi Caeli et Nova Terra
